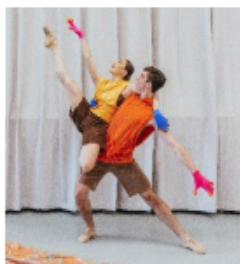
This program is for you if you want to:
