What's been happening in the Art Room?

Over the past few weeks in Art, students have been exploring the colour wheel and learning all about primary and secondary colours.

We began by learning about the primary colours, red, blue and yellow. We were inspired by the artwork of Piet Mondrian and created our own artworks using bold lines and blocks of colour. Students focused on selecting the correct paint brush, carefully controlling their brush strokes and painting neatly.

Students then moved on to learning about secondary colours by mixing the primary colours themselves. The P-2 students used their new colour-mixing skills to create wonderful paper bag chickens, using orange, green and purple in their designs. Our Grade 3-6 students also explored secondary colours and were inspired by Wassily Kandinsky and created colourful overlapping balloon artworks.

It has been wonderful to see students building their confidence with painting techniques while learning how artists use colour to express ideas and create eye-catching artworks.
