SCHOOL CROSSING RULES

Parents are urged to set a good example for children by safely entering and exiting the school crossing. When the flags are displayed at a children's crossing, you must stop for pedestrians who are waiting to cross, or who have started crossing. You must remain stopped until the crossing is clear. These rules apply even if there is no crossing supervisor.

A driver approaching a children's crossing, or driving to and from the crossing must drive at a speed at which the driver can, if necessary, stop safely before the crossing!

These rules and responsibilities for school crossings are to support schools to reduce the risk of accident or injury!
