READY SET PREP 2026

HEAD LICE

Recently there has been an increasing number of cases of head lice reported across our school.

We understand that this can be a sensitive issue for families but we must be vigilant in treating students and ending the life cycle of head lice.

People get head lice from *direct hair to hair contact* with another person who has head lice. This can happen when people play, cuddle or work closely together.

Head lice do not have wings or jumping legs so they cannot fly or jump from head to head, they only crawl.

We have found the most effective treatment to be the conditioner and fine tooth comb method as detailed:

Step 1 Comb any type of hair conditioner on to dry, brushed (detangled) hair. This stuns the lice and makes it difficult for them to grip the hair or crawl around.

Step 2 Now comb sections of the hair with a fine tooth, head lice comb.

Step 3 Wipe the conditioner from the comb onto a paper towel or tissue.

Step 4 Look on the tissue or the comb for lice and eggs.

Step 5 Repeat the combing for every part of the head at least four or five times.
